



Parking Restrictions



As the day actually approaches (OK, so it's still several months away) when the LRT will stop at 76th Avenue and at South Campus, a number of people in the community are looking forward to what this could mean for our streets. Potentially lots of drivers using our streets for park and ride is the general consensus. Which means we should do something now if we don't want this to happen. (And this is what I am hearing.)

Traditionally, petitions are passed block by block and if most people on the block want to have parking restrictions installed and the community league is in agreement, it can be done. IF it is contiguous with other areas with restrictions. In other words, if enough signatures are gathered on 75th Avenue between 114th and 116th, we could ask to have parking restriction signs installed there. If, however, it is very difficult to find the necessary number of people home on 74th Avenue to sign a petition, not only will signs not be installed there, but it also blocks avenues to the south from being able to ask for them.

So – we propose requesting help from our councilors to have all residential streets in Belgravia provided with restricted parking. As is presently the case in most of the area north of 76th Avenue, this would mean allowing cars to park for up to two hours, and issuing Belgravia residents parking permits for their own vehicles. If any of you would oppose such an action, please contact me at guilbert@ualberta.ca or 780-437-5807. Otherwise, the community league will move forward with this request.


